## Wangaratta Fat Cattle Market Report

617

A much heavier yarding of 617 head were presented at Wangaratta Livestock Exchange. This was 322 more than last week and comprised of 551 young cattle, 63 cows & 3 bulls.

Quality was mixed but there was a sprinkling of better steers and bullocks through the sale. Heifers were in short supply, but a better selection of milk vealers were penned.

The better quality steers and bullocks sold to strong demand to be 5 cents dearer, while all others remained firm. The offering of heifers remained firm while the better milk vealers were 2 to 4 cents dearer, average quality offerings eased by 5 cents.

The 63 cows sold at a firm rate.
