## Wangaratta Fat Cattle Market Report

A lighter yarding of 242 head came forward at the Wangaratta Livestock Exchange .This was 52 less than last week and comprised of 180 young cattle and 56 cows & 6 bulls.

Quality was good with a good selection of steers, a quality penning of heifers principally medium weights but very few vealers on offer. There was a better selection of cows penned.

Demand was again stronger with grown steers firm to 4 cents dearer and heifers rose in value by 5 cents. The butcher vealers were firm to 4 cents dearer while restockers paid up to 10 cents above last week for turning out steers and heifers. The heavier yarding of 56 cows saw a rise in value by 5 cents.
