Wangaratta Fat Cattle Market Report

A much heavier yarding of 421 head were offered to buyers at the Wangaratta Livestock Exchange. This was 226 more than last week and comprised of 384 young cattle, 29 cows and 8 bulls.

Quality overall was good with a reasonable offering of steers, the heifers penned were of good quality and a variation in weights. There was a very good offering of milk vealers. Only 29 cows were on offer.

All; buyers were in attendance and competed strongly, however bullock and steers eased in value to be 5 cents cheaper, the heifers sold to strong demand to be 8 to 10 cents above last week while vealers sold firm to 5 cents dearer. Cows eased by 5 cents.
