Important Information for Pool owners

A reminder with summer here that all pools and spas that are capable of holding a water depth of more than 300 millimetres require a compliant child safety barrier/fence.

Most people with permanent in-ground and above-ground swimming pools are aware of the requirements, but a lot of people are not aware that these requirements extend to small temporary pools, including inflatable ones, which remain full of water and are not emptied on a daily basis. They also apply to spa's, even when they have lockable lids.

For existing pool owners now is the time to check that your Pool Safety Barrier is in proper working order. Check that pool gates are still self-closing and that pool furniture and pot plants are not located where a child could use them to climb over the fence and enter the pool enclosure.

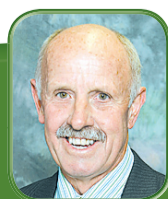
