

# Community Banner Project FAQ

## Who can design a banner?

Anybody can design a banner! A total of 65 winning banners will be selected which will be enlarged and printed for you to hold along the route of the baton relay on the day. We will select two banners from each school and the rest from the general public.

## Where can I get a banner template?

You can get a hard copy of the banner template from Customer Service at the Wangaratta Government Centre, or online at [www.wangaratta.vic.gov.au](http://www.wangaratta.vic.gov.au).

## Do I need to design my banner by hand?

No, you can also design your banner on a computer. You can download the PDF version at our website [www.wangaratta.vic.gov.au](http://www.wangaratta.vic.gov.au). Just remember, we will only accept 2D designs.

## What should I draw on my banner?

You can design your banner anyway you like, but remember, it needs to reflect the theme of *humanity, equality and destiny*. You also can't include rude or offensive language or images.

## How big will the banner be after it's printed?

All winning banners will be enlarged to 2m x 1m.

## When do I need to hand my banner in by?

All banners must be submitted by 5pm Monday 18 December. You can submit them in person to Customer Service at the Wangaratta Government Centre or by email to [events@wangaratta.vic.gov.au](mailto:events@wangaratta.vic.gov.au)

## What will happen once I hand my banner in?

Once you submit your banner, our judging team will assess all the entries and choose the winning selection. We will then send the winning designs off to be printed in December/January. All of the entries will be displayed in the Wangaratta Government Centre and Performing Arts Centre in February.

## When will I get my banner back if I'm one of the winning entries?

If you're one of the winning selections, your printed banner will be ready to pick up at the Wangaratta Government Centre in early February, just in time for the main event!

## Where will I stand with my banner on the day of the event?

We will get in touch with you about this a little closer to the event. We are hoping to create a hub of banners and people around the handover points for the relay. These will be confirmed in December.
