

## Application for a Schedule 13 Permit to Burn by an Individual Owners & Occupiers

**WARNING: Section 38 of the Country Fire Authority Act 1958 is as follows:**

**Section 38 (3)**

*A person who fails to comply with the conditions or restriction contained in a permit issued under sub section (1) shall be guilty of an offence and liable to penalty of not more than 20 penalty units or to imprisonment for a term of not more than twelve months or to both that penalty and imprisonment*

**Section 38 (4)**

*Compliance with the conditions of a permit does not of itself relieve the holder of a permit from liability for any damage sustained by another person as a result of any fire lit by the holder of the permit pursuant to that permit.*
