The Wangaratta Aerodrome is owned and operated by the Rural City of Wangaratta with sealed and grass runways. The Aerodrome is located 7km South of Wangaratta along the Wangaratta – Kilfeera Rd Road (Greta Rd) and 1.5km south of the Hume Freeway.

### **Air Traffic Control**

No formal air traffic control exists at Wangaratta. All traffic is required to operate under Common Traffic Advisory Frequency (CTAF)

### **Runways**

Runway 18/36 is sealed and is 1640 meters in length with pilot activated lights (PAL) for night landing and non directional beacon facilities. Frequency for PAL is 119.20 or manual.

Runway 09/27 is grass and is 530 meters in length. This runway may be closed due to wet conditions. (check NOTAMS for closures)

### **Taxiways**

Two 15 meter wide taxiways provide access from the Regular Public Transport (RPT) and General Aviation (GA) Aprons.

### **Regular Public Transport Apron**

The RPT apron servicing the terminal building comprises of a flexible pavement with a sprayed seal surface. The apron is approximately 150 meters long and varies between 30 and 45 meters wide.

There are no marked parking positions on the apron, and aircraft normally park parallel with the building line.

### **General Aviation Apron**

The main General Aviation Apron is situated directly north of the RPT Apron and has a sealed surface in front of two hangers and the **Wangaratta Aero Club**. It has a grassed surface towards the 18/36 Runway where light aircraft park.

### **Joy or Charter Flights / Pilot Training**

The Wangaratta Aero Club – [www.wangaeroclub.com.au](http://www.wangaeroclub.com.au) provide a charter service, joy flights and pilot training services at the Wangaratta Aerodrome.

### **Terminal Facility**

The terminal facility includes public toilets, showers (9am to 5pm Monday to Friday). No public phone exists at the terminal. External public toilets are available 24hrs 7 days a week. The Terminal also has a privately operated kiosk.
