



EXTENSION OF TIME TO A PLANNING PERMIT

Request Form

Pursuant to Section 69 of the Planning & Environment Amendment (General) Act 1987

A permit holder can request an extension of time:

- before or within 6 months after the permit expiry date, where the use or development allowed by the permit has not yet started; and
 - within 12 months after the permit expiry date, where the development allowed by the permit lawfully started before the permit expired.
- If a request is made out of time, the responsible authority cannot consider the request and the permit holder is not able to apply to VCAT.
