Objection to grant a Planning Permit

This form is to assist in making an objection as outlined in the Planning and Environment Act 1987. Please contact the Rural City of Wangaratta Statutory Planning department for assistance in completing this form.

Any person who may be affected by the granting of a permit may object.

- If you object the Council must consider the objection unless you withdraw it.
- If you object you must state the reasons why and say how you would be affected by the granting of a permit.
- The Council may reject an objection that it considers has been made primarily to secure or maintain a direct or indirect commercial advantage for the objector.
- If you object prior to the Council making a decision, you will be notified of the Council's decision.
- If you object and are not satisfied with the Council's decision you can appeal within 21 days of the notice of the decision to the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT).
- If the Council refuses the application, the applicant can also appeal Council's decision.
- Certain application types are exempt from notice (advertising) and in these instances Council is unable to consider objections.
