Camping Permit Conditions

- Application must be completed, and all supporting documents supplied before your application can be processed.
- If Applicant is not the landowner, written consent from the landowner must be provided with the completed application.
- Sanitary facilities must be an EPA approved system and must be used at all times.
- The camp site only to be occupied by the approved number of occupants at any time.
- The permit is subject to review on receipt of any substantiated complaint.
- Ensure camp site does not cause a detrimental effect to the amenities of the area.
- Ensure wastewater can be effectively disposed of so as not to cause an odour/nuisance.
- If the site is covered by a Bushfire or Flood Overlay, ensure that you have an emergency management plan in place.
- Council reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time if in the opinion of an Authorised Officer if any condition of the permit is being breached.
- If Applicant wishes to undertake open air burning please speak to Council as a Permit to Burn may be required. Check for total Fire Ban Days prior to lighting any fires/commencing open air burning.

Note: during the declared fire danger period (usually December to April) a Permit to Burn must first be obtained from the municipal fire prevention officer under the CFA Act 1958.
