Permit conditions

The following conditions apply when burning off:

- Fire to be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Notify Fire Permits Victoria a minimum 2 hours prior to lighting fire online at www.firepermits.vic.gov.au.
- Adequate water supply/hose to be ready for use at all times to extinguish fire.
- Burn off hours between 8.00am and 4.00pm on any given day.
- Fire is to be extinguished prior to leaving site (must not smolder overnight).
- Notify adjacent neighbours prior to lighting fire.
- Only burn dry combustible materials.
- Cleared fire break of a minimum of 3 metres all around.
- The matter being burnt does not exceed 3 cubic meters.

The following items are not allowed to be burnt:

- Plastic
- Waste petroleum oil or any waste containing petroleum oil
- Paints or empty paint containers
- Pressurised cans
- Textile fabrics
- Rubber
- Food waste
- Illegal substances
- Any other noxious material
