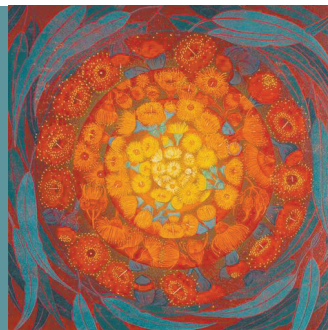

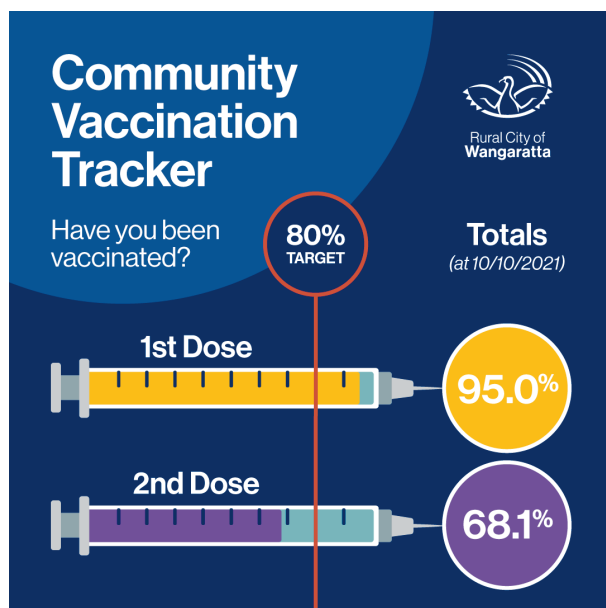

Draft Procurement Policy 2021

Submissions are invited on Council's Draft Procurement Policy 2021. Section 108 (6) of the Local Government Act 2020 requires Council to adopt a procurement policy in compliance with the Act within 6 months of the commencement of this section which began 1 July 2021.

How do I make my written submission?

Copies of documents on public exhibition can be obtained from the Wangaratta Government Centre and on Council's website at www.wangaratta.vic.gov.au

Any person affected by the proposals may make a written submission relating to the draft documents.

We have extended the time frame for submissions - Submissions will be received up to 5pm on Friday 5 November 2021.

In your written submission, you may also request to be heard by a Committee of Council in support of your submission, prior to Council considering the proposal. Submitters will be notified before the relevant meeting date.
