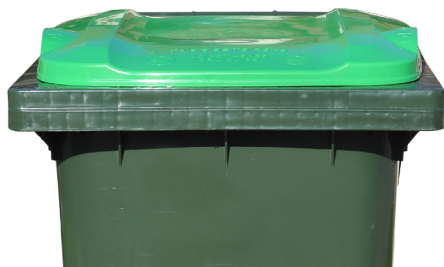

What **CAN** go in the **GREEN** organics bin

- ✓ Dairy products
- ✓ Eggshells
- ✓ Left over foodwaste
- ✓ All fruit including citrus
- ✓ Pet droppings
- ✓ Food scraps & Peelings
- ✓ Tea bags & coffee grounds
- ✓ Meat & bones
- ✓ Small branches
- ✓ Garden clippings & weeds
- ✓ Grass clippings
- ✓ Leaves
- ✓ Tissues
- ✓ Paper towels
- ✓ Shredded paper
- ✓ Cooking oils (absorbed in paper towel first)



What **CANNOT** go in the **GREEN** organics bin

- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Plastic wraps
- ✗ Plant pots
- ✗ Household rubbish
- ✗ Gravel or soil
- ✗ Kitty litter
- ✗ Large branches or logs
- ✗ Concrete
- ✗ Fencing materials
- ✗ Steel
- ✗ Biodegradable plastic bags
- ✗ Cling wrap
- ✗ Nappies
- ✗ Cigarette butts & ash
- ✗ Recyclable containers
- ✗ Liquid cooking oils



What **CAN** go in the **YELLOW** recycling bin

- ✓ Biscuit trays
- ✓ Laundry and bathroom containers
- ✓ Glass bottles & jars
- ✓ Rigid plastic containers & bottles with recycling codes 1-7
- ✓ Aluminium & steel cans, aerosols & foil containers
- ✓ Paper products
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Newspapers & magazines
- ✓ Plastic plant pots
- ✓ Cardboard



What **CANNOT** go in the **YELLOW** recycling bin

- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Green waste
- ✗ Clothing/shoes
- ✗ Batteries/car parts
- ✗ Electronics
- ✗ Rope or wire
- ✗ Toys
- ✗ Nappies
- ✗ Drinking glasses/ mirrors windows/ windscreen glass
- ✗ Crockery/ tableware
- ✗ Liquids (cooking or chemical)
- ✗ Gas cylinders
- ✗ Syringes
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Waxed boxes
- ✗ Computers



What **CAN** go in the **RED** garbage bin

- ✓ Hard plastics
- ✓ Polystyrene
- ✓ Broken crockery & glass
- ✓ Plastic wrapping
- ✓ Nappies
- ✓ Plastic bags
- ✓ Waxed cardboard
- ✓ Crockery & glassware
- ✓ Broken toys
- ✓ Rope



What **CANNOT** go in the **RED** garbage bin

- ✗ Recyclable containers
- ✗ Paper & cardboard
- ✗ Green waste & food organics
- ✗ Cooking oil, chemicals/ liquids
- ✗ Asbestos
- ✗ Electronic waste*
- ✗ Flammables*
- ✗ Batteries*
- ✗ Timber*
- ✗ Concrete*
- ✗ Furniture*

***Larger items including timber, concrete, furniture and metal are to be disposed of at the Transfer Station**
