Where do I take items too big
for my household bin?

Council Transfer Stations

The Transfer Station can accept items too large for your household bin and recycle items that cannot be placed in your kerbside recycling bin.

You can recycle the following items for FREE at the Wangaratta Transfer Station:



- ✓ Used motor oil
(up to 20L containers)



- ✓ Household
batteries



- ✓ Light
globes



- ✓ Paint and
paint tins

The following items can be recycled for FREE at ALL Transfer Stations:



- ✓ Steel



- ✓ Household
recyclables



- ✓ White goods
(Excluding fridges
and freezers)



- ✓ Car batteries

What **CANNOT** be accepted at Transfer Stations?

- ✗ Asbestos (can be accepted
at Bowser Landfill by
appointment)
- ✗ Liquid Waste
- ✗ Fire Extinguishers
- ✗ LPG Cylinders over 10kg
(including car cylinders)
- ✗ Chemicals

Other items that can be recycled:

- ✓ Gas bottles (up to 10kg)
- ✓ Electronic waste (Ewaste)
- ✓ Mattresses
- ✓ Tyres
- ✓ Timber
- ✓ Greenwaste

*DrumMuster approved chemical
drums can be disposed at
Wangaratta or Moyhu Transfer
Station upon an appointment.
Unwanted household chemicals
can be disposed through the
Detox Your Home mobile
chemical collection program.*
