• Watch and play sports




Be celebrated

| Accessibility Reference Group | A group of community members which work with council to make the community more accessible and inclusive |
|----------------------------------|--|
| Awareness | Making sure someone knows about something |
| Business | Where people work to make and sell products or services {Shops} |
| Funds | Another word for money |
| Hearing Loop | A tool that allows people to hear what is being said at events |
| Inclusive | Being welcoming and having everyone be a part of |
| Marveloo | Portable/moveable disabled toilet |
| Policies | A set of ideas or plans that is used for making decisions |
| Sign Language | A way of communicating for people who have trouble hearing |
| Training | Learning new information and skills |
| Work experience | Learning while doing a job |
