Easy Read Budget Breakdown (2025)

Updated September 2025

For easy understanding, we divide the Home Care Package funding into three parts:

- **Funds for Care** - This is the amount you can use for services like personal care, cleaning, light gardening, nursing
- **Care Manager (20%)** - This pays for your Care Manager to help plan and organise your care.
- **Package Management (15%)** - This covers the cost of managing your package and keeping everything running
