

Set within the vibrant Ovens Riverside Precinct, the Riverside Square is an ideal venue for small performances, charity events and fundraisers. The square features a tiered stage that can also function as seating and is well lit for evening activity and performance.

Site Suitability & Suggested Capacity

The Ovens Riverside Square is nestled between commercial buildings on either side and is limited in its footprint and capacity. In particular, there is limited space for temporary infrastructure like marquees or vehicles. This limited space makes it an ideal venue for low impact events with a recommended capacity of 500 people.

Shared Use Considerations

At the rear of the square runs the Ovens Riverside Walk which provides pedestrian access between Faithfull Street and Parfitt Road including riverfront businesses. Access should be maintained along the length of this thoroughfare.

The venue also shares boundaries with two businesses and impacts a suite of restaurants, cafes and bars on Faithfull Street. Consideration must be given to impacts on these businesses.

In particular, vehicle access in the laneway behind the stage must be maintained during business hours to allow access to this private property. **Under no circumstances are vehicles to be parked in this laneway (even for pick up and drop off purposes)**

Amplified Sound Considerations

Due to the direction of the stage and close proximity of nearby businesses, noise must be carefully managed in close consultation with neighbours. It is recommended that events running independent of nearby businesses limit noise to acoustic performances.

Community Notification and Consultation

Notification and consultation requirements will depend on the size and nature of your event and potential impacts to the community. Council may require any event to undertake notification activities including; letter box drops, on-road signage prior to the event and advertising in local newspapers.

At a minimum you should consider communication with the businesses in Faithfull Street.

Toilets

There are no public toilets within the Square or Riverside Precinct. The nearest toilets are located at King George Gardens on Ovens Street. These toilets may be considered for public events provided adequate signage is present to direct event patrons. Events that are enclosed or require toilets for alcohol service will need to provide facilities on-site.



Vehicle Access

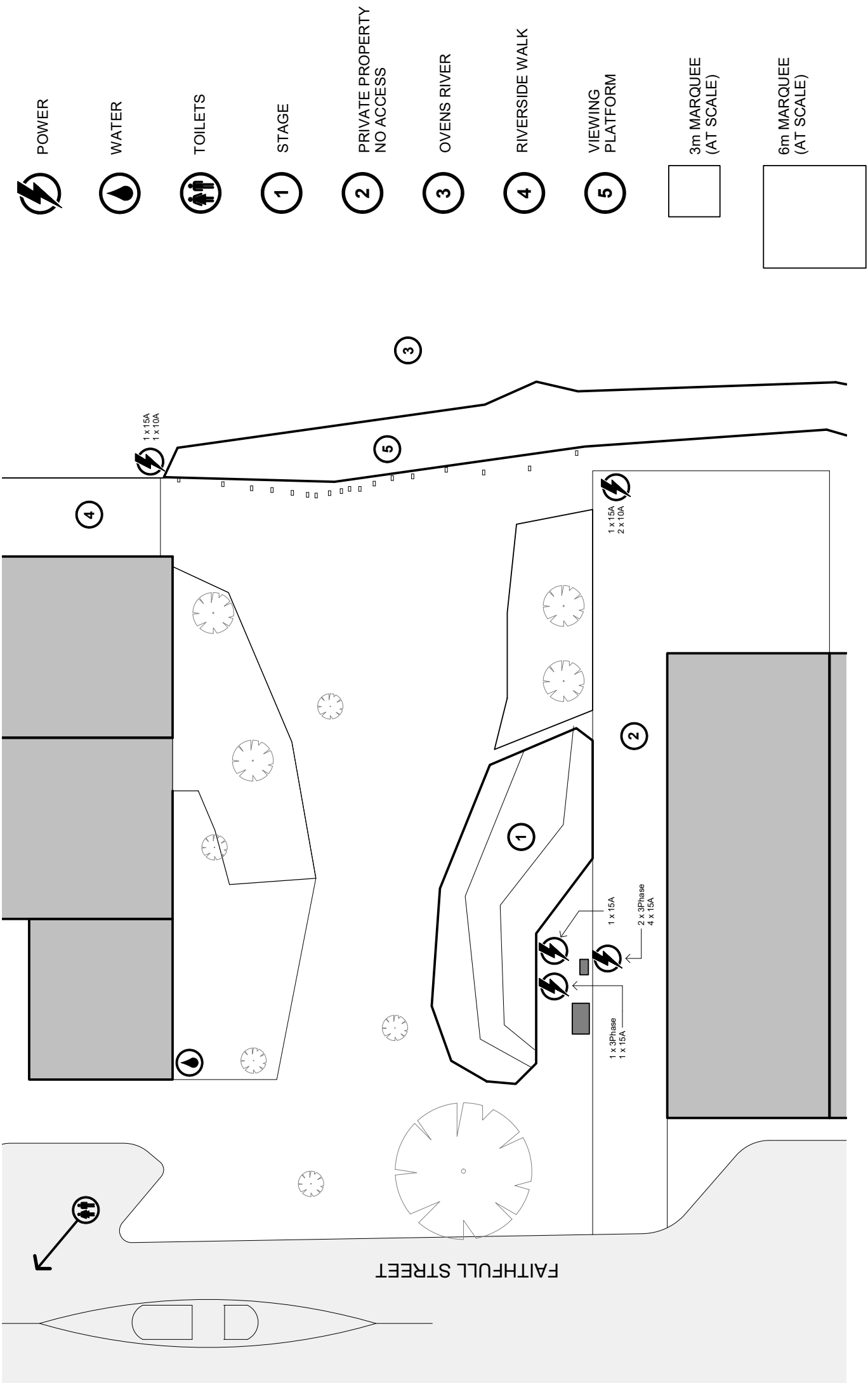
Vehicle access to the site is via vehicle bollards from Faithfull Street. Access to this gate requires a key which can be requested as part of your event application. Vehicle access should be actively managed during set-up and pack-down periods to minimise interface with pedestrians and cyclists.

Power

The Ovens Riverside Square has significant power across the site. Please refer to the Ovens Riverside Square venue map for power locations and types. All power boxes in Ovens Riverside Square require a key which can be requested as part of your event application.

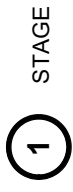

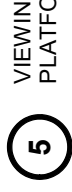

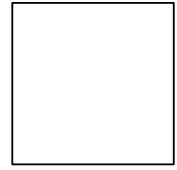
